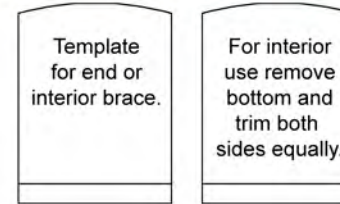
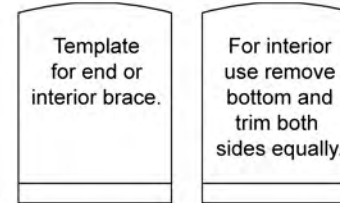


Door overlay for 3D use



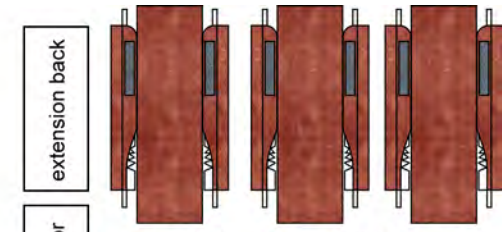
Template for end or interior brace.

Fold around matte board for triple layer pivot beams

Guard compartment will be greatest challenge. Glue tabs are suggestions only, try ignoring all but textured tab. Turn it under and fit to 210-250gsm card for back, then fill widest part with length of matte board, tapered to fit; form curved side and glue ends under.



Sheet metal for queenpost and buffer wrap, etc.

Fold strips over matte board to make triple layer length of 'timber' for underframe components



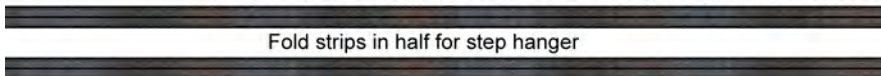
While all required textures are included here, the small size of the model may require trimming or other adjustment of some components.

Pivot beams, solebars and timbers (above for underframe, steps, etc.) fold and glue around card to create structural timbers. Create headstock as part of end to ensure structural integrity. Floor fits inside headstocks/walls with side walls extending roughly 1/3rd of solebar width below bottom of floor. Roof texture is oversize, trim to fit and colour underneath to avoid exposed white card. Interior bracing may be required to keep walls straight or to support roof. Trim heights as needed and sides of template evenly to fit inside walls.

Decide on coupling before starting construction and adapt as needed. Small HOn30/OO9 bogies should work satisfactorily, adjust location of pivot beam (bolster) if necessary. Fine pins, set in pre-drilled holes make queenposts with fishing line or brass wire for truss rods.



Fold strips around matte board to make multiple layer length for solebar



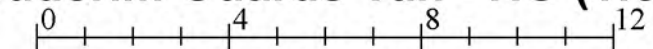
Fold strips in half for step hanger
