With the first try, I realized that the wheel sets could not be installed without first cutting away some of the plastic with a Dremel Tool (and if I turn the first car upside down, an observer will be able to see the makeshift cutting I performed).

I found a head on color photo of this building and painstakingly removed the white sport car in the original photo. I did not buy Photoshop but rather used the free Paint software bundled by Microsoft.



I then consulted the two photographs that I had of the building (one shown above), imagined what the whole building would look like by and copied/pasted the missing parts to complete the structure for modelling (below).
