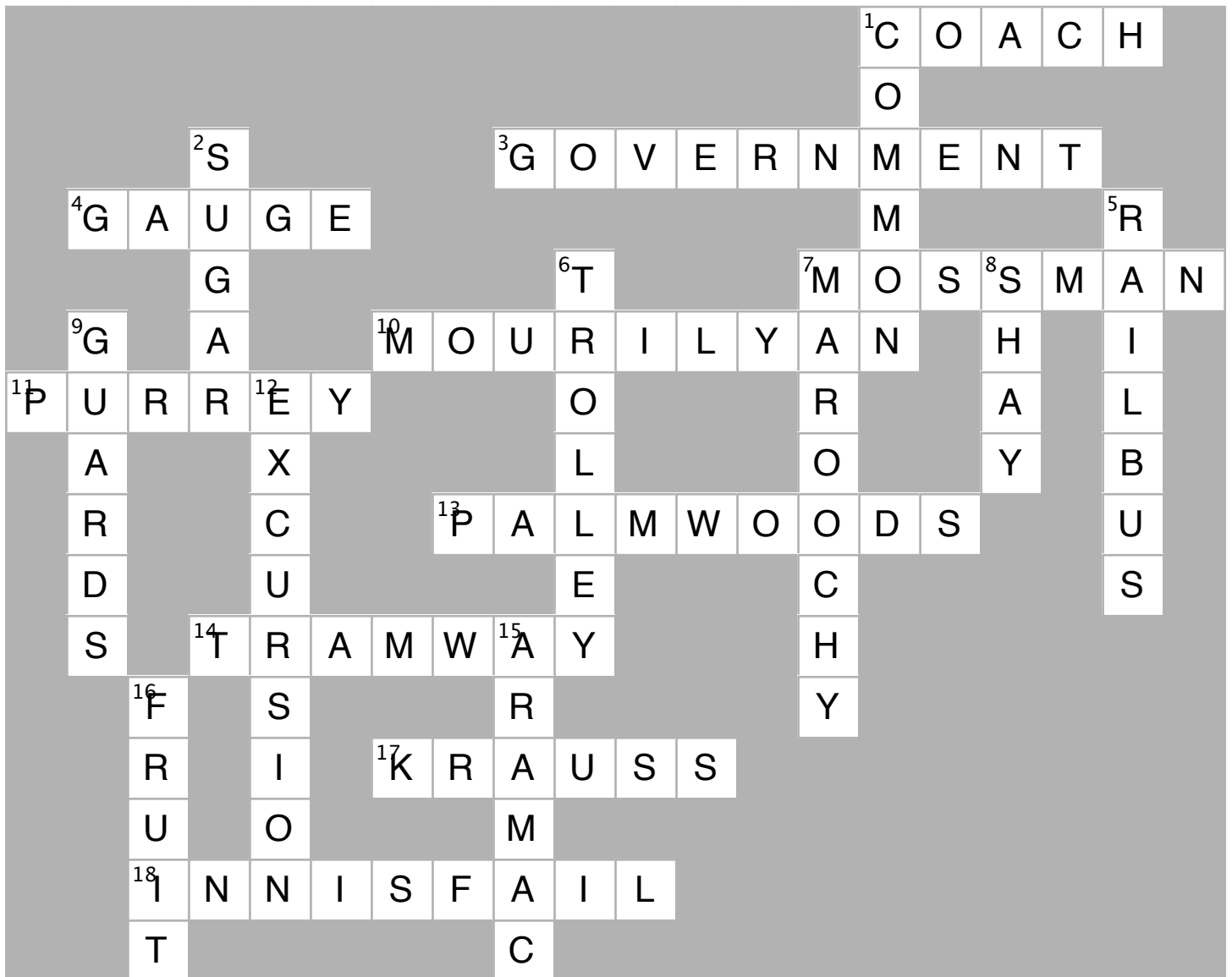

- Available as a model kit [COACH]
- Unusual owner of 2' gauge railway [GOVERNMENT]
- Distance between rails [GAUGE]
- Tramway tourists transported to hotels [MOSSMAN]
- Harbour tramway [MOURILYAN]
- French-built [PURREY]
- About an hour to travel 11.5 km to ?? [PALMWOODS]
- Local authorities or registered companies owned [TRAMWAY]
- Restored Buderim-Palmwoods loco [KRAUSS]
- Originally named Geraldton [INNISFAIL]

Down

- Carrier authorised for both passengers and freight [COMMON]
- Often hauled during the harvest season [SUGAR]
- Self-propelled passenger vehicle (2) [RAILBUS]
- Individually owned for use on Mill tramlines [TROLLEY]
- River with sandbar problems [MAROOCHY]
- Mapleton Tramway's best known loco(s) [SHAY]
- Smaller coach with ?? compartment [GUARDS]
- Weekend operation on tramway [EXCURSION]
- Last Shire-owned railway [ARAMAC]
- Longitudinal seating on ?? box and planks [FRUIT]
